HOUSE HÄMMERLE

The steep hillside location was used to its full advantage: on the side facing the hill, a concrete wall surrounds the paved front yard and the entrance next to the garage, which is integrated into the house. The upper floor is divided by corridor, staircase and elevator shaft into a kitchen/dining/living area and a bedroom area with bathroom and dressing room. A window strip running the whole length of the house creates a vista over the valley. The compact, solid construction is covered from base to gable with a ventilated fibre cement veneer façade, giving the entire structure a pleasantly pared-down character.
